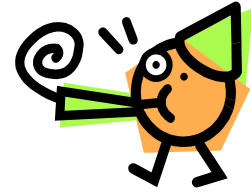
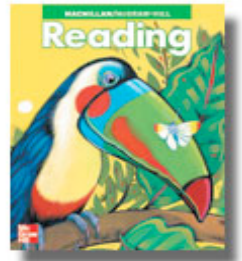


**Mrs. Andreula's Class
