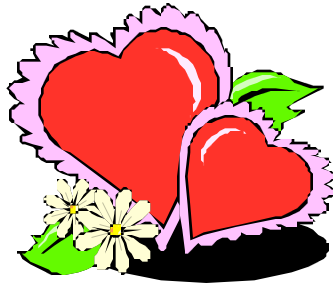

1st Grade and 2nd Grade Language Arts

We will be reviewing our Wilson sounds every day. Keep practicing and review for your spelling tests on Wednesdays. We will continue to read stories from the McGraw Hill reader focusing on story elements.

2nd Grade Math

We are finishing adding 2 digit numbers with regrouping. We will begin subtracting 2 digit numbers the week of Jan. 28th. Practicing at home will help reinforce these skills.



3rd Grade and 4th Grade Language Arts
