#### **Investigation Findings**


- **□**Non-HIB Event (Unfounded)
  - ➤ Incident did not meet the criteria of a H.I.B. event or code of conduct violation.
- **□**HIB Event (Founded)
  - ➤ Incident did meet the criteria of a H.I.B. event as defined by the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights / district policy.
- □ Code of Conduct Violation
  - Incident did not meet the criteria of a H.I.B. event, but identified as a code of conduct violation.



## Elementary Level January 2021 – June 2021






