Dear Extended Day Parents,

We wanted to reach out with details regarding the Extended Day Program.

Change to Programming

Throughout the last year, we have engaged in a review of the entire Extended Day Program. As part of this review, we have expanded the enrichment offerings to students, extended our hours of service, and updated safety and security policies and procedures. An additional outcome from this review process is the decision to collaborate with Nutley's Parks and Recreation for programs during school breaks (February and Spring) and potentially summer camp. This program will operate from 7:30am to 5:30pm, at similar pricing. We have worked diligently to ensure that there are still options for working parents during the school breaks even though the Extended Day Programs will no longer be offered in the district during these times. As with all programming decisions, we will continue to evaluate and monitor the effectiveness of this change. These adjustments will allow us to continue to focus on providing quality, enriched before and after care to our students in an academic setting, when school is in session.

Session Three Enrichment Courses (February - March)

We are excited to offer the next session of enrichment for the Extended Day Program. The third session (February – March) will offer TaeKwonDo, Mindful Crafts, and the second year of the TREP\$ program. Enrollment for these sessions will open on www.myschoolbucks.com on Thursday, January 17. Schedules will be available at the time of registration.

TaeKwonDo

Master Kim from Korea TaeKwonDo in Nutley will offer one-hour introductory sessions to each school during session three. This enrichment session will teach self-defense, focus, respect, self-control, and perseverance with basic taekwondo moves to better your child's mind and body. The cost will be \$15. This will be open for Extended Day students in each building in grades 3-6, and will be limited to 30 seats per school.

Mindful Crafts

Teachers from the Nutley Public Schools will offer an opportunity to create and innovate through different craft projects which build growth mindset. The cost will be \$25. This will be open to Extended Day students in each building, in grades K-6, and will be limited to 25 seats per school.

TREP\$

TREP\$, short for enTREPpreneur\$, teaches students in grades 4-8 how to start their own businesses in 6-8 weeks. They learn the lessons in the six weekly workshops, and apply them at home as they build their business with the help of their families. The whole school community comes out to enjoy the TREP\$ Marketplace where the young entrepreneurs launch their businesses together.

TREP\$ sessions will be held at John H. Walker Middle school (transportation will not be provided by the district). The program will conclude with the TREP\$ Marketplace on the evening of Friday, 4/26 at Nutley High School. The cost of TREP\$ will be \$55. This will be open for Extended Day students, as well as non-extended day students, and will be limited to 110 students.
