### Kindergarten

- Appropriately sized backpack
- Light snack every day. (No glass or candy). Please keep Kindergarten snack and after care snack separate.
- **IMPORTANT-** All supplies (glue sticks, crayons, pencils, erasers, scissors, and folders) will be provided on the first day of school. Your child does NOT need to bring these items.

### First Grade

- 1 backpack (No wheels)
- 4 Large Elmer's glue sticks
- 4 Erasers (pink)
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils with erasers, SHARPENED
- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 pair of kids scissors - 5" blunt/rounded
- 1 (3 pack) of 3x3 post-its - yellow
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 4 thin dry erase Expo markers (fine point)
- 1 NEW black sock (for erasing dry erase markers)
- 1 box of colored pencils SHARPENED
- 1 three (3) ring binder - 1" Heavy Duty with view pocket on front.
- 1 pack of pocket dividers- 5 tab write-on/label
- 1 pack of clear page protectors
- 1 pencils sharpener -manual with removable lid
- 1 pair of headphones (over the ear)

- 1 Play-Doh (4 pack)
- 1 towel to sit on (for outdoor snack)
- 2 boxes of facial tissues
- 2 canisters of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 package of baby wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (Large)
- 1 roll of paper towels (Large)

## **Second Grade**

Please label all supplies with your first and last name.

- 1-inch binder with a clearview cover
- sharpened #2 pencils (12 or 24 count)
- crayons (16 or 24 count)
- colored pencils (12 or 24 count)
- safety scissors
- 3 glue sticks
- 3 blue or black white board erasable markers
- a handheld pencil sharpener

## **Third Grade**

- Backpack
- A 3-ring binder. Please purchase a 1 1/2", 3-ring binder with a clear pocket cover (known as presentation binder).  
No Trapper Keepers please!
- 2 different colored 2 pocket folders: Plastic recommended  
1 for Spanish and 1 for Music
- A zippered pencil case
- 2 boxes of pencils-Ticonderoga recommended
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 container of Lysol Wipes or Clorox Wipes
- 3 large boxes of tissues
- 4 Post-It pads, 2 different colors—3 in. x 3 in.
- 4 highlighters-any color
- Multiplication & Division flash cards
- A small flashlight for "Flashlight Friday"
- 1 pair of headphones or earbuds
- Colored pencils-optional  
(Students receive a box of crayons, but seem to prefer colored pencils)

- 1 Red ***extra large or jumbo book*** sock (Math)
- 1 black and white marble notebook
- 2 packs of sharpened pencils
- 1 pack colored pencils
- 1 pack multi-colored highlighters
- 2 colored pens for correcting
- 4 dry erase markers
- 4 packs Post-its
- Small hand-held sharpener with cover
- 2 glue sticks
- **Inexpensive pair of headphones or earbuds**
- 1 container hand sanitizer
- 1 container of cleaning antibacterial wipes
- 3 boxes of tissues
- Protractor
- 6 qt plastic container with lid (13" x 8 x 4) for supplies
- Please label supplies with your child's name

- 2 packages of Post-It notes
- Package of erasable Papermate pens (blue or black)
- 2 colored pens
- Hand sharpener with cover
- Copy of your favorite summer reading book
- Optional for the classroom: Box of tissues
